When Creativity Won't Come

READ: God created man in His own image. . .

Genesis 1:27

REFLECT: "You can make anything you want," the teacher said, placing jars of paint in the center of each table. I watched as the preschoolers began swiping and swirling the colors across their papers.

When the pictures were done, we arranged them along the wall: a strawberry tree; a blue dog; a lady with six hands, "because by mommy's always saying she needs more hands." I was impressed that each drawing was unique. Such creativity!

I thought about my own life. How routine it had become. I made the same meatloaf, drove the same routes, prayed the same phrases. I even made the same mistakes.

God is the great Creator—and we are His children, made in His image. Creativity is our heritage! Yet often we face both our opportunities and our problems with tunnel vision. Creativity enables us to see things in new ways, to produce original solutions, to break out of the "but-we've-always-done-it-thisway" rut.
